



BARTLESVILLE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

The City of Bartlesville Parks and Recreation Department has contracted the services of PROS Consulting of Dallas, Texas to develop a Parks and Recreation Development Plan. This plan will serve as a decision-making tool for the future development and management of the City's parks, recreation, and open space.

When completed the plan will:

- Provide a conceptual framework or blueprint to identify the parks and recreation needs of the citizens
- Establish an appropriate park and recreation system plan to guide City leadership in meeting the needs of the citizens of the City of Bartlesville
- Document the capital available and resources required to meet the expectations of the community
- Be a "living-document" that can be reviewed and updated by the City as necessary

The foundation of this plan will be based in community and stakeholder input. Public input will be gathered through focus group interviews with key community leaders and stakeholders, public forums, and community surveys. The City invites the public to participate in a televised public forum to be held at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 22, 2008 in the City Council Chambers. This meeting will be open to the general public and will be designed to ensure information is presented and feedback is gathered from citizens at large. We welcome your attendance and comments at that meeting and encourage you to invite others in the community to attend.
