4. Discuss and take action to adopt the Bartlesville Municipal Authority FY 2020-2021 Budget. Presented by Jason Muninger, City Clerk/CFO and Secretary to the Bartlesville Municipal Authority.

Mr. Muninger reported that the Bartlesville Municipal Authority (BMA) budget was considered during the City's budget discussions but must be approved separately from the City budget by law. The Authority maintains three funds, but there are no appropriations for the BMA –

General Fund in this year's budget. The total appropriations for the Authority as a whole are \$14,333,921. A majority of the budgeted amounts are for debt service and to reimburse the Water and Wastewater Operating funds for operating costs. The main sources of revenue are water and sewer service fees and investment earnings. The Total BMA – Wastewater Fund is \$4,853,591 and the Total BMA- Water Fund is \$9,480,330.

Mr. Curd moved to adopt the BMA FY 2020-2021 Budget as presented, seconded by Mr. Stuart.
