MINUTES

(The Notice of Meeting was posted December 13, 2019 and the Agenda was posted July 2, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.)

City Council members present were Mayor Dale Copeland, Vice Mayor Alan Gentges, Mr. Jim Curd, Jr., Mr. Trevor Dorsey and Mr. Paul Stuart.

City staff present were Mike Bailey, City Manager; Jess Kane, City Attorney; Jason Muninger, City Clerk/CFO; Terry Lauritsen, Director of Water Utilities; Micah Siemers, Director of Engineering; Shellie McGill, Director of the Public Library; Nancy Warring, Assistant City Planner/Grants Administrator; and Elaine Banes, Executive Assistant.

- 1. Mayor Copeland called the Business Meeting of the City Council to order immediately following the Bartlesville Municipal Authority meeting at 7:13 p.m.**

Vice Mayor Gentges moved to award Bid No. 2020-2021-004 to Jeff Graham Construction, Collinsville, Kansas, in the amount of \$340,734.50, seconded by Mr. Stuart.

A brief discussion was held about the project, and a timeline for start of the project was given as mid-to-end of August 2020.

10. Public hearing to assess and discuss the City's performance in the administration of the grant received from the State of Oklahoma for Fiscal Year 2018 CDBG Small Cities Set-Aside Program and take possible action to approve a resolution formally accepting the project as completed. Presented by Nancy E. Warring, Asst. Planner/Grants Administrator.

Ms. Warring reported that one requirement of participation in the CDBG Small Cities Set Aside Program is the holding of a final public hearing after completion of the project to assess and discuss the City's performance in the administration of the grant. The City received funding for FY 2018 in the amount of \$67,962 which was used with matching city funds in the amount of \$76,786.44 for the construction of a playground and sidewalks near the entrance to Johnstone Park. Over the past six years, the City has been improving the south section of Johnstone Park with a pavilion, restrooms, improved vehicle access and a parking lot. However, there was limited pedestrian access and no play equipment in this section of the park. Therefore, the project funding was to install a playground and sidewalks. Ms. Warring provided a presentation showing the completed playground in the shape of a pirate ship, and the sidewalks.

Mayor Copeland opened the public hearing at 7:50 p.m. There being no one appear to speak, Mayor Copeland closed the public hearing at 7:51 p.m.

Mr. Stuart moved to approve the resolution formally accepting the project as completed as presented, seconded by Vice Mayor Gentges.

11. Discuss and take possible action to approve a resolution calling and giving notice of an upcoming election for City Council Representatives for all wards of the City of Bartlesville, Oklahoma. Presented by Jess Kane, City Attorney.

Mr. Kane reported that per City Charter, all five councilmembers come up for re-election every two years in a non-partisan general election, if needed. This year that election date will be November 3, 2020. The filing period for the election will begin at 8 a.m. on Monday, August 3, 2020 and close at 5 p.m. on Wednesday, August 5, 2020. City Council representatives are nominated by Ward and elected by the qualified electors of the Ward. Each candidate must be a qualified elector of the City for six months prior to the time of the elections and must be a qualified resident of his/her respective Ward for six months prior to the time of the election.

Vice Mayor Gentges moved to approve the resolution calling the election for November 3, 2020 as presented, seconded by Mr. Dorsey.

Mr. Stuart commented that councilmembers must be 25 years of age prior to November 3, 2020.

13. City Manager and Staff Reports.

Mr. Bailey provided a report on the status of the State and County regarding COVID-19 cases.

He also reported that Frontier Pool will be closed until the part arrives for the pump; the Downtown Street Renovation is now underway; that the Pathfinder Project is complete; the Tower Center at Unity Square ribbon cutting is scheduled for 5:50 p.m. Friday, July 10; and he thanked the Bartlesville Kiwanis Club for a successful 4th of July fireworks display.

At the Mayor's request, Mr. Bailey explained the bike lanes and that the sharrows painted on these lanes do not mean "bicycles only". The sharrows are there to guide bicyclists on the bike approved path, and to also alert drivers of vehicles to be aware of bicyclists in the marked lanes.

Mr. Curd complimented the contractor on the Pathfinder Project on a job well done.

Mr. Stuart also remarked how well the construction of the new skate park is coming along.


14. City Council Comments and Inquiries.


